Missouri Association of Licensed Professional Counselors (MOLPC) was formed to provide a costeffective avenue for Missouri Licensed Professional Counselors (LPC) that wish to maintain a close link with the American Counseling Association of Missouri and their professional identity and political advocacy.

The mission of the Association is to enhance the quality of life in society by promoting the development of licensed professional counselors, advancing the counseling profession, and using the profession and practice of professional counseling to promote respect for human dignity and diversity in the state of Missouri.

This association is for licensed professional counselors who are committed to furthering the practice of professional counseling and who in work in educational, health care, residential, private practice, community agency, government, and business and industry.

MOLPC goal's are:

- ! To enhance the practice of professional counseling in any setting.
- ! To promote ethical and responsible professional practice.
- ! To encourage cooperation with other organizations and associations related to clinical practice, theoretical development, and research in professional counseling.
- ! To provide leadership and support for the profession of professional counseling.

The four membership levels are:

<u>Professional Member</u> - A person with a master's degree or higher in counseling or a closely related field and is a Licensed Professional Counselor and is a member of ACAM. Each professional member is eligible to vote.

<u>Associate Member</u> - A person with a master's degree or higher in counseling or a closely related field and is a Provisionally Licensed Professional Counselor (PLPC) or a Counselor in Training (CIT) may be accepted as an associate member. Associate member is a member of ACAM. Each associate member is eligible to vote

<u>Student Member</u> - A student engaged in graduate study in counseling or a closely related field in an accredited institution may be accepted as a student member upon recommendation of his/her faculty advisor. Student member is a member of ACAM.

<u>Affiliate Member</u> - Any person who supports MOLPC objectives and has an interest in affiliation without meeting requirements for professional, associate or student membership may be admitted. Affiliate member is a member of ACAM.

Students and Affiliate members are non-voting members

The membership fee for Professional Members is \$15.00 and for Associate, Affiliate and Student Members is \$5.00.
